Cases of Hope 373 Suitcases Provided

This was a BIG year for our prison ministry as we responded to fulfill hundreds of requests for released inmates who were eligible for early release this past summer. We are currently providing a packed suitcase and carry-on of essentials to four local correctional facilities.



Back to School 220 Students Served

This year, we had the honor and privilege, to use Annie, our box truck, to partner with the underserved area of Petersburg as well as providing small appliances to those families identified as "homeless" and living in extended stay motels in Henrico.



WeCare 22 Directly Impacted
